### Summing up the first meeting event between our mentors and program participants.

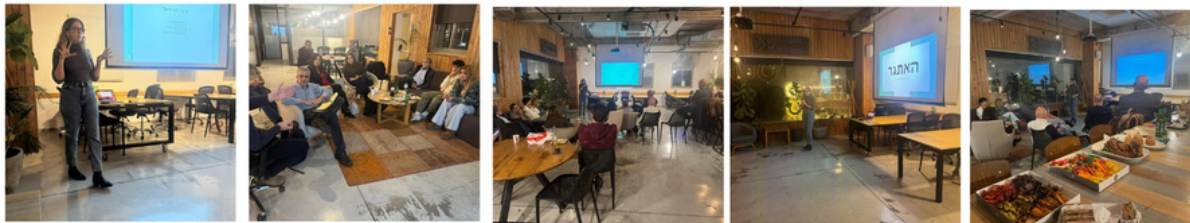
We want to thank everyone who participated in yesterday's kickoff event and came to meet the fantastic mentor team of ScienTech! So, what we did there?
